1. Pre-registration of home school status is required before arrival. (See above for details)

2. Rates with Walk In proof are \$10.00 / lift ticket and \$10.00 / ski rental for 6 – 16 year olds.
3. Rates with Walk In proof are \$12.50 for 17 and up. Persons 17 and up must accompany a student.
3. Regular rates will be charged for persons not supplying documentation the day of purchase.
4. Children must be 6 years old and no older than 16 to participate in lessons.
5. The home school lift ticket is valid during the hours of 10:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. on designated days.
6. We ask parents and other adults to help the children put on their lift tickets and fill out their rental forms if necessary. They will also be asked to direct the children to the rental room to get their equipment. We will also ask them to help the children put their skis on outdoors.
7. We ask that you do not bring large coolers or crock pots. Ski Gull provides a concession stand with items to compliment your lunch from home or to provide you with a meal while enjoying your time at our facility.

Ski Gull Home School Ski Lesson Program / 6-16 years

Dates: Friday, January 15, 2010 Limit 8

Rate: \$20.00 per student; includes FREE ski rental
\$10.00; season pass holders

1. Pre-registration of home school status is required before arrival.
2. Children must be 6 years old and no older than 16 to participate in the ski lessons.
3. A short orientation will be provided at promptly at 10:30 a.m. This presentation will be an introduction to the sport of skiing. The instructor will also provide important information on lift ticket and rental room procedures.
4. Lessons will begin at 10:45 a.m. and finish at 12:00 p.m. Lift ticket is good through 3:30 p.m.
5. We ask parents and other adults to help the children put on their lift tickets and fill out their rental forms in a quick and orderly manner. They will also be asked to direct the children to the rental room to get their equipment. We will also ask them to help the children put their skis on outdoors. The entire procedure should take only 30 minutes.
6. Once the children are ready and outside they will proceed to the station area for lessons. The lesson area consists of 6 stations, they are:
Station 1: Wedge – stop (snowplow)
Station 2: Wedge on hill (come to a stop)
Station 3: Right turn, Left turn and Wedge come to a stop
Station 4: Right turn, Left turn and Wedge come to a stop (ski turns with coaching)
Station 5: Course testing, around cones
Station 6: Chair lift loading and unloading

Ski Gull Home School Snowboard Lesson Program / 6 to 16 years

Dates: Friday, January 15, 2010 Limit 4

Rate: \$30.00 per student; includes free snowboard rental.
\$15.00; Season Pass Holders

1. Pre-registration of home school status is required before arrival.
2. Children must be 6 years old and no older than 16 to participate in the snowboard lessons.
3. A short orientation will be provided at promptly at 10:30 a.m. This presentation will be an introduction to the sport of snowboarding. The instructor will also provide important information on lift ticket and rental room procedures.
4. Lessons will begin at 10:45 a.m. and finish at 12:00 p.m. Lift ticket is good through 3:30 p.m.
